

COVID-19 TESTING

What you need to know



If you have mild or no symptoms:

Stay home and practice good social distancing, which means you should remain at home, and stay at least 6 feet away from others.

If you are sick enough that you would normally have sought medical treatment if the outbreak of COVID-19 was not occurring, call your healthcare provider.



If you have traveled internationally recently:

Stay home. Monitor yourself for the development of a fever, cough, or shortness of breath for at least 14 days from when you return. Contact the Richland County Health Department at 406-433-6947 to notify staff of your return. See the above recommendations about contacting your healthcare provider.



If you have traveled in the US recently:

Monitor yourself for the development of a fever, cough, or shortness of breath for at least 14 days from when you return. Maintain social distancing. See the above recommendations about contacting your healthcare provider.
