Social Distancing-Please describe your plan for maintaining a minimum of 6 feet of separation between patrons in your establishment: *Our limited max capacity is 14. 4 tables are removed to provide left of spacing. No one will be served at the bar, those waiting for a table will wait in their car. we will take names.*

Staff will self monitor + self report to supervisor. No ONE is allowed at work sick. Those who show symptoms will be sent home immediately + must be symptom free 24 hrs before returning.

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Public Health Requirements: Please check which of the following requirements you will be instituting (*hint: they are all required*):

- Food and drinks are served only to seated customers
- Customers that arrive together may sit together
- Capacity is limited to 50% of normal operating capacity (check your occupancy certificate from the Fire Department)
- Groups must be spaced 6 feet from the next group, or there must be a physical barrier between groups
- Tables of more than 6 customers are not permitted
- Patrons are not allowed within 6 feet of the drink preparation area
- All surfaces occupied will be cleaned and sanitized between customers
- Table items, including condiments, menus, décor, etc., will be **(please circle)** removed from the table, OR cleaned and sanitized between customers
- Self-service areas will be closed. All self-service supplies are handed to customers
- Drink refills are not allowed

Public Health Recommendations: Please check which of the following recommendations you plan to institute:

- Offering masks or face coverings for staff and/or patrons
- Install sneeze guards or other barriers between staff and patrons, where applicable

Casino Only- Please check how you will protect casino patrons (*hint: they are all required*):

- (Please circle) Gaming machines that are operational are separated by 7 feet, center-to-center, OR machines will be placed out of service if adequate spacing cannot be assured.**
- Gaming machines will be cleaned and sanitized between customers.
