#### COVID-19 Case Update

Richland County currently has eight active cases of COVID-19, and 16 cases that are considered recovered, for a total case count of 24 cases during this pandemic. Recent case updates are as follows:

##### *Active cases*

Case 24: A male in his 20's who is not hospitalized and is isolating at home. The case investigation is ongoing. The case was identified through contact tracing. The individual became symptomatic while undergoing quarantine.

Case 23: A male in his 20's who is not hospitalized and is isolating at home. The case investigation is ongoing. The case was named as a close contact to a positive case. The individual became symptomatic while undergoing quarantine.

Case 22: A male in his 50's who is not hospitalized and is isolating at home. The case investigation is ongoing. The case was a household contact to a named close contact. The individual became symptomatic while undergoing quarantine.

Case 21: A male in his 20's who is not hospitalized and is isolating at home. The case investigation is ongoing. The case was named as a close contact to a positive case and was quarantined. The individual is asymptomatic.

Case 20: A female between the ages of 10-19 who is not hospitalized and is isolating at home. The case investigation is ongoing. The case was identified through contact tracing. The individual became symptomatic while undergoing quarantine.

Case 18: A male in his 20's who is not hospitalized and is isolating at home. The case investigation is ongoing. The individual was symptomatic.

Case 16: A male in his 50's who is currently hospitalized. The case investigation is ongoing. The case was named as a close contact to a positive case. The individual was symptomatic.

Case 10: A male between the ages of 0 and 9 who is not hospitalized and is isolating at home. The case was identified through contact tracing.

##### *Recovered cases*

Case 19: A male in his 20's who has recovered. The case was not hospitalized and isolated at home. The individual was symptomatic. The mode of transmission is currently unknown.

Case 17: A female in her 30's who has recovered. The individual was not hospitalized and isolated at home. The case was named as a close contact to a positive case. The individual was symptomatic.

Case 15: A female in her 50's who has recovered. The case was not hospitalized and isolated at home. The case was identified through a positive case from another county through household exposure.

Case 14: A male in his 50's who has recovered. The case was not hospitalized and isolated at home. The case was identified through a positive case from another county through household exposure.

Case 13: A female in her 20's who has recovered. The case was not hospitalized and isolated at home. The case was identified through contact tracing.

Case 12: A male in his 30's who has recovered. The individual was not hospitalized and isolated at home. The individual was symptomatic.

Case 11: A female in her 60's who has recovered. The individual was not hospitalized and isolated at home. The case was identified through contact tracing, and had been undergoing quarantine when symptoms developed.

Case 9: A female in her 40's who has recovered. The case was not hospitalized and isolated at home. The case was identified through contact tracing.

Case 8: A female in her 40's who has recovered. The case was not hospitalized and isolated at home. The case is believed to have been acquired through domestic travel.

Case 7: A male in his 20's who has recovered. The case was not hospitalized and isolated at home. The case was named as a close contact to a positive case.

Case 6: A female between the ages of 10 and 19 who has recovered. The case was not hospitalized and isolated at home. The case is a household contact to a positive case.

Case 5: A male in his 40's who has recovered. The case was hospitalized, released and continued to isolate at home. The case is a household contact to a positive case.

Case 4: A female in her 40's who has recovered. The case was not hospitalized and isolated at home. The mode of transmission to the case is currently unknown.
